BACKGROUND

SEDA in conjunction with the **Estevan Comprehensive School** is pleased to invite your province to send a delegation of students to participate in the 2011 Junior Debate Nationals in Estevan, Saskatchewan

THEME

Energy Resources

RESOLUTIONS

Prepared topic: To Be Announced by April 4, 2011

Impromptu topics will focus on national issues.

DATE

Thursday, May 12th to Sunday, May 15th, 2011 (travel days included).

ELIGIBILITY

Each province and territory is invited to enter up to 4 two-person teams. The students must be from grades 7 to 9. Selection of the delegates is at the discretion of each province's debate organization. If additional space is available after the registration deadline, additional teams may be invited.

SUPERVISION

Each provincial delegation **must** be accompanied by at least one adult delegate/supervisor. Adult delegates are expected to coach and supervise the students throughout the event.

TRAVEL

All delegates are required to arrive in Regina on Thursday, May 12th. Delegations are responsible for their own transportation to and from Regina. Delegates arriving at the Regina airport will be met by SEDA staff and will stay at the Luther College University Residence in Regina Thursday evening. Delegates will travel to Estevan on Friday, via Weyburn. Delegates should arrange for flights after 4:00 pm on Sunday or make their own arrangements to stay overnight in Regina on Sunday.

ACCOMMODATION

All delegates and coaches will be accommodated at the Best Western Plus in Estevan. SEDA will make all the room bookings for registered student and adult delegates. Students are expected to share quad accommodations; adults double accommodations. Due to the high demand for hotel rooms in Estevan, it may be necessary to accommodate some delegations in our "overflow" hotels if there are several double or single occupancy requests.

FEES

\$325 per both student and adult delegates. This includes Thursday accommodations in Regina, Friday & Saturday hotel in Estevan, local transportation and most meals. There will be a \$100 extra charge for any adult requesting single accommodations, or for each student requesting double occupancy.

DEADLINE

All fees, registration forms, liability waivers, and travel information forms must be received in the SEDA office by Friday, April 8, 2011.

NOTES

We would appreciate it if every regional coordinator would send us *all registrations in one complete package, or at least a list of all expected delegates.*

Contact SEDA if there are any special needs to accommodate or if the above conditions present any problems.

Bring umbrellas and good walking shoes – it is a **7-10 minute walk** from the hotel to the school. Information about Rules, formats, etc. can be found on the web site.
