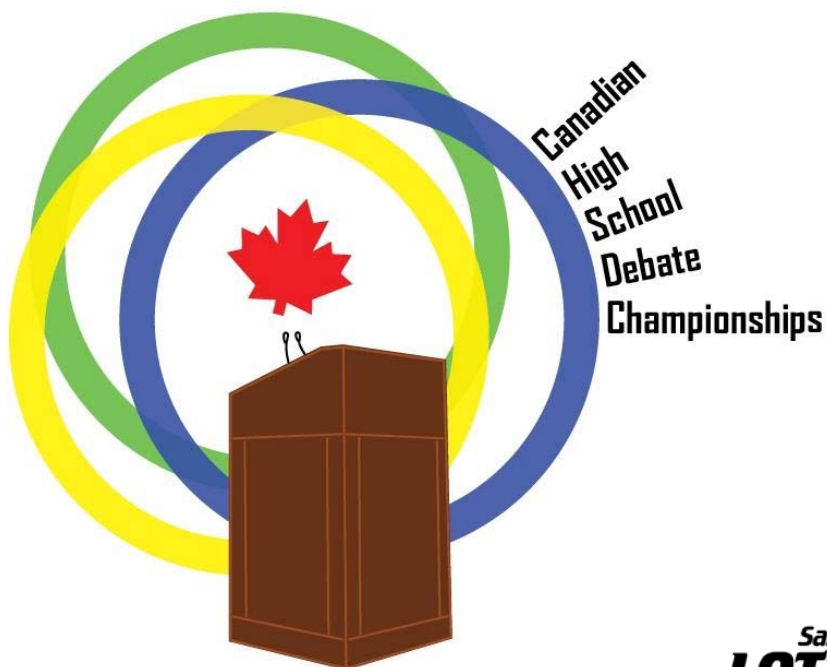

## SUPERVISION

Each provincial delegation **must** be accompanied by at least one adult delegate/supervisor. Adult delegates are expected to coach and supervise the students throughout the event. Parents are welcome, but must pay the fees.

Delegations are responsible for their own transportation to and from Regina. Delegates will be met by SEDA at the airport and transported to the Hotel.
